## Lower Merion Library System Local Authors Collection Policy Approved by the LMLS Board September 12, 2017

- 1. Each library in the Lower Merion Library System will decide where its Local Author Collection shall reside.
- 2. Titles in the collection will be identified with a classification prefix of LA followed by relevant call number information, and a Local Author spine label.
- 3. Works to be added to the collection are works by either a previous long-time resident, or a current resident, or feature the Lower Merion Township community. These works are not necessarily governed by the same selection criteria as gift books or purchased items <u>as detailed in the LMLS Materials Selection Policy</u>, but can be <u>included</u> at the discretion of the Head Librarian, and the LMLS Selection Committee.
- 4. Items must be in a format and language currently collected by the Lower Merion Library System.
- 5. Because of limited funds, LMLS requests that authors donate works that may be added to the collection. Depending on demand, the library may decide to purchase additional copies.
- 6. All donated volumes become the property of the library and are subject to deselection.
- 7. Items in the Local Author Collection will circulate to the public following the guidelines in the current Circulation Policy.
- 8. Basic cataloging records will be added to the catalog. A standard subject heading of Lower Merion Township, PA Local Authors will be used for all entries.
